Representative Payee

The Social Security Administration allows Villa Crest to serve as representative payee for recipients. As representative payee, Villa Crest can receive the Social Security income, pay the monthly liability, and maintain the personal needs funds in a separate trust account.

Appointing Villa Crest as the representative payee is a simple change to make, just stop by the business office and speak to Cynthia Peterson. The Social Security Administration may take a month or two to complete the process after the application is filed.
